What: Atlanta Team Pickleball Combo Doubles Season - Spring 2025

When: Thursday nights; 7PM start time. 6 to 8 weeks of play + City Finals (typically scheduled on a weekend day)

Where: Home and away league format. See rules document for more information on approved facilities

Teams: Consist of minimum two (2) men and two (2) women. There is NO MAXIMUM number of players required on a team. Captains have the discretion to create a team with as many players as necessary to avoid defaults of play.

Format of play: All team matches will be three (3) rounds of two (2) lines, two (2) games each to 11 (win by 2 points). *Refer to the team match format visual in the rules document*

NOTE: The 2 women and 2 men who compete in the first round of gender doubles MAY BE DIFFERENT than the 2 women and 2 men who compete in the mixed doubles rounds of play. However, once the mixed doubles partnerships have been determined for the first round of mixed doubles play, the players MUST remain the same for the second round of mixed doubles.

Cost: \$35 registration fee/person

Important Dates:

Registration Opens.....March 3rd, 2025

Registration Closes.....April 6th, 2025

Regular Season Play Begins.....April 24th, 2025

Regular Season Play Ends.....May 29th, 2025

Additional Information:

- All players **MUST** have a DUPR account prior to the first week of matches of the regular season. Remember, a player is not required to have a DUPR rating but is required to have a DUPR **account** prior to week 1 of regular season play
- Courts should be certified through Match Time requirements. Please contact the League Coordinator for facility approval prior to registration if your facility uses tennis nets
- Players competing in each division must have a MAXIMUM DUPR rating of the following:

3.0 Division → 3.49

4.0 Division → 4.49

3.5 Division → 3.99

4.5 Division → 4.99

NOTE: If a player has 5 matches or less in the DUPR rating system, this is NOT considered part of their average. These players can go by a Captain’s Rating. The player is required to discuss their rating to be entered with the captain. The player will enter the agreed-upon rating as a “Captain’s Rating”. The “Captain’s Rating” should reflect that player’s skill as accurately as possible.
