



## **Local Procedures For COVID-19 Exposure**

In the event a USTA League player who, within the previous 14 days, competed in a local league match is diagnosed positive for COVID-19, the following procedures should be implemented:

### Step #1. (Player's Responsibility)

- Once the player has received the positive test results, they are to notify their captain (via email) of the date and time of their test, the match or matches they played in where they believed they could have been a potential carrier, and who their partner and opponents were.

### Step #2. (Captain's Responsibility)

- Once the captain is notified of a "COVID-19" positive player (Step #1) they are to notify their local league coordinator (via email) and the captain of the opposing team or teams that their player competed against.
- The captain is to confirm the players directly involved in the match played by the "COVID-19" positive player. (singles; 1 additional player, doubles; 3 additional players)

### Step #3. (Local League Coordinator's Responsibility)

- The local league coordinator is to confirm that all the information regarding the situation with the captain (Who is the player? Where was the match? Who was the player's partner? Who were the opponents? Has everyone been notified?)
- The local league coordinator will send an email out to both captains with additional information regarding the recommending safety guidelines per the USTA.
