

THE RUNDOWN

What: Atlanta Team Pickleball Same-Gender Season (Men & Women divisions)

When: Tuesday nights (women divisions), Thursday nights (men divisions); 7PM start time. 6 to 8 weeks of play which includes regular season and playoffs, followed by City Finals (typically scheduled on a weekend day)

Where: Home and away league format. See rules document for more information on approved facilities

Teams: Consist of a minimum of four (4) players. There is NO MAXIMUM number of players required on a team. Captains have the discretion to create a team with as many players as necessary to avoid defaults of play.

Format of play: All team matches will be two (2) rounds of two (2) lines, three (3) games each to 11 (win by 2 points). Note: The same lineup of players that played in Round 1 will play in Round 2, but they will swap opponents.

Therefore, once partnerships have been determined for the first round of play, the players MUST remain the same for the second round of play. *Refer to the team match format visual in the rules document*

Cost: \$35 registration fee/person

Important Dates:

Registration Opens......July 1st, 2025

Registration Closes.....August 3rd, 2025

Regular Season Play Begins....week of August 18th, 2025

Regular Season Play Ends....week of September 22nd, 2025

Additional Information:

- All players MUST have a DUPR account prior to the first week of matches
 of the regular season. Remember, a player is not required to have a DUPR
 rating but is required to have a DUPR account prior to week 1 of regular
 season play
- Courts should be certified through Match Time requirements. Please contact the League Coordinator for facility approval prior to registration if your facility uses tennis nets
- Players competing in each division must have a MAXIMUM DUPR rating of the following:

3.0 Division \rightarrow 3.49 4.0 Division \rightarrow 4.49

 $3.5 \text{ Division} \rightarrow 3.99$ 4.5 Division → 4.99

NOTE: If a player has 5 matches or less in the DUPR rating system, their DUPR rating will not be used for the league's season. The player will consult with the captain and enter the agreed upon rating as a "SELF RATE" at the level they intend to play. Any results garnered during the league season or other results will NOT impact the player's "division eligibility" for that season
