

## **APPLY TODAY FOR THE USTA ATLANTA BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

### **2027-2028 TERM**

USTA Atlanta is a nonprofit community tennis association (CTA) within the United States Tennis Association network. USTA Atlanta runs one of the largest local tennis associations in the country, including USTA adult leagues and junior team tennis. The staff handles the daily operations, while the Board focuses on governance and leadership.

The Board of Directors for USTA Atlanta primarily provides the governance, strategy, financial oversight, and policy direction for the organization rather than handling day-to-day operations.

The Board's responsibilities generally include:

- Setting the organization's overall mission and strategic priorities
- Establishing policies for leagues, junior programs, and community initiatives
- Overseeing finances, budgets, and long-term sustainability
- Hiring and supervising the Executive Director
- Supporting tennis growth and community engagement across metro Atlanta
- Leading committees and volunteer initiatives
- Representing the interests of players, captains, facilities, and the broader tennis community

The Board Often:

- Reviews league policies
- Approves budgets and major expenditures
- Helps guide partnerships and sponsorships
- Supports fundraising and community outreach
- Ensures the organization is aligned with broader United States Tennis Association, USTA Southern, and USTA Georgia objectives

**Board Member Commitment:** Board members are expected to attend monthly board meetings and commit to volunteering throughout the year in support of USTA Atlanta's programs and initiatives. Some members may also choose to serve on committees aligned with their interests and expertise.

The Board is volunteer-driven. Many members are long-time tennis volunteers, league participants, captains, tennis professionals, or community leaders who help shape the direction of tennis in Atlanta.
